Handicap Parking

Arrival:

Entrance to the park will be via the Katy Lane Gate. There will be a "Check-In / Registration" pavilion where volunteers will have your registration packet. The packet *should* include such items as meet badge, parking permit, vendor data sheets, etc. It *should* also have your track assignment if you are bringing a train to the meet. The volunteers working "Check-In / Registration" will try to answer your questions. ***Patience Please!***

Handicap Parking:

Our hobby is a senior hobby and as such a very large number of our members have handicap stickers displayed in their vehicles. We just don't have that many special parking places.

So our 4 Handicap Parking areas located in Central Station will be designated 15 minute Handicap Load / Unload only. What this means is that when you arrive, if you have or use a wheel chair or other motorized chair / scooter or similar device, you will be allowed up to Central Station to unload your handicapped person and associated gear at one of those 4 locations. After unloading your driver / attendant will exit out the Main Gate and return to the Katy Lane gate and be directed to the new Handicap Attendant parking area. We will make every effort to expedite your attendants pickup and transport up to your awaiting handicapped person. All others, including walkers if able, will be asked to park in our designated spots in South Meadow and take advantage of one of our shuttles to Central Station.

If this is not going to work for you per your particular handicap situation please contact the Triennial Committee for a possible solution. Do not contact the Office. Remember ***Patience*** is all that we ask.
